NOTE: Teams may share grills. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and up to 3 team members. Each team will have a 10 x 10 foot space. Electricity will be provided but limited to 120 v. No campers, trailers, or motor homes are allowed. No pets are allowed. Be prepared to serve at least 150 people. All equipment, supplies, and personal items must fit within your designated area. Please bring your own trash bags and deposit trash bags in dumpster. Keep your area clean at all times.

Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start the natural substances, but not to complete cooking. Holes for open pits are not permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. Grease traps must be utilized to prevent grease drippings on the grounds. Each team MUST bring a fire extinguisher.

- Fajitas-Beef skirt only, must be made on site
- Beans-Dry pinto beans, cooked on site, nothing bigger than the bean allowed poured into a cup. The only exception would be pork salt for cooking purposes only. Any entry with anything larger than the bean will be disqualified.
- Salsa- must be made on site-No Pico de Gallo, salsas only

## Head Cooks Meeting will take place on Friday, October 6, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. (Gym IPAD Lab)

Meat inspection will be held Saturday, October 14, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. Any and all meat and/or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking will not be allowed prior to the start of the cook-off as defined by the cook-off official.

Limit one Jackpot entry per team. (Beans, Salsas, and Chili)

Excessive use of alcohol beverages may be grounds for disqualifications. Alcoholic beverages rules must be followed (example: poured into cups). Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants.

IWA, Sisters of the Incarnate Word, and Cook-off officials will not be responsible for accidents, theft, or any mishaps.

Set up of equipment will NOT be allowed prior to registration. Participants may setup starting at 9 a.m. If you set up prior to space assignment, you WILL be moved.
